



EXAMINATION TERMS AND CONDITIONS APPLY

In line with the regulation of the ABRSM Online Music Examinations, here are our Terms and Conditions

1. Eligibility and Registration

- Candidates must register for the examination within the specified registration period.
- All required personal details and examination information must be provided accurately during registration.

2. Examination Fee

- The examination fee must be paid in full at the time of registration.
- Fees are non-refundable, except under exceptional circumstances as outlined in the refund policy.

3. Technical Requirements

- Candidates must have access to a reliable internet connection and a device capable of video recording and playback.
- A quiet, well-lit environment free from interruptions is required for the duration of the examination.

4. Identification

- Candidates may be required to show a valid form of identification at the beginning of the examination.

5. Examination Content and Format

- The examination will consist of the required elements as outlined in the syllabus, including performance pieces, scales, sight-reading, and aural tests.

- Examinations must be recorded in one continuous take, with no editing or splicing of the video.

- Recorded videos will be used solely for examination purposes and securely stored.
